PRE-DESIGNED CONCENTRATIONS SAMPLES

These pre-designed concentrations are intended for informational purposes; each represents a topic within political economy and contains four courses that are typically offered on campus, though not every semester or even every year. They are neither meant to be exhaustive or prescriptive—meaning students should think of these as starting points for creating a concentration on a topic of primary interest to themselves. We fully expect that there will be variations within each topic, but best practice is always to cover a topic in *political economy*, **which may involve a course or two that focuses on economics**, whether inside the Economics Department or not.

Students should also note that if they have a deep interest in one of the methodologies that can be used to inform their concentration, they can propose to replace one of the courses in these concentrations with an appropriate methodology (e.g. Econometrics—Econ 140, Data C104-Human Contexts and Ethics of Data, or Demography 110-Intro to Population Analysis).
